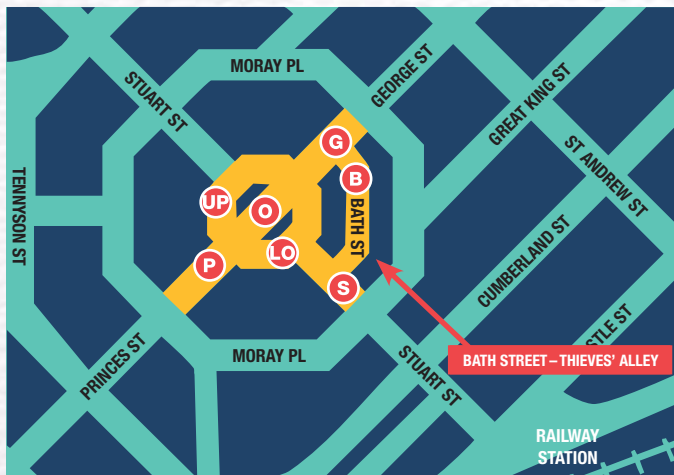
During October we will advertise in newspapers from Christchurch to Southland for stallholders.

STALLHOLDER CONDITIONS

THIEVES' ALLEY MARKET DAY SATURDAY 13 FEBRUARY 2010

1. If handling food you must comply with DCC Environmental Health requirements. These will be posted to you with our Registration Confirmation.
2. Any electrical or gas equipment must comply with the appropriate regulations and be in a safe condition.
3. Vehicles will be permitted into and out of the market area between 7.00am and 9.30am and from 4.00pm to 5.30pm. No vehicles, except for emergency services, will be allowed in the closed area outside those times.
4. Market Day opens to the public at 10am and closes at 4pm. A condition of participation is that your stall remains in place and operating until 4pm.
5. Entrances to neighbouring business premises must be kept clear at all times.
6. Explosives, firearms and alcohol are prohibited within the market area.
7. The Dunedin City Council will not be responsible for any personal injury to you, or for damage to, or loss or theft of your property. You should ensure your property is appropriately insured, and secured.
8. Definition of business stall – trading as a business for profit/ GST Registered.
9. In the unlikely event of a problem or emergency, the decision of DCC Events is final.
10. Stall space is 3.5m wide x 3m deep.
11. No refunds after 1 December 2009.
12. **Notification of site 10 days prior to event.**
13. Hired trestles 2.4m x .75m delivered to site
14. Free early-bird parking in Bath Street and upper Filluel Street carpark (not Pay and Display area)
