| Community Plan (LTCCP) | To identify what the Council will achieve in the next ten years. | Reviewed every three years, with full review every six years (2012/13). |
| Annual Plan | Includes the Annual Plan - setting the annual budget priorities for Council spending | Draft Annual Plan issued for consultation and submissions – March 2010. |
| Tertiary Precinct Development Plan | To ensure a co-ordinated approach to planning for the joint campus area, and to identify future infrastructure needs. | Development Plan launched in October 2008. Ongoing opportunity for community involvement in implementation. |
| Community Support Strategy and Implementation Plan | To create a city where residents feel included and connected with their wider community. | Consultation on draft strategy – end 2010. |
| District Plan | Code of Subdivision and Development | Consultation on draft code – late 2009. |
| District Plan | Rural Landscape Plan Change | Consultation on draft plan change – late 2009. |
| District Plan | Heritage/Townscape Plan Change | Consultation with working party study – December 2009. |
| District Plan | Transportation Section Plan Change | Consultation on draft change – December 2009. |
| Coastal Reserve Management Plans | Management of the dune reserves from Brighton to Waikouaiti. | Consultation on draft Plan – November 2009 to February 2010, |
| Urban Design Strategy | To establish the future form of the city and priorities for amenity development. | Consultation on draft strategy – mid 2010. |
| Parks and Reserves Strategy (including Reserves Acquisition and Disposal Strategy) | To provide guidance and set priorities for the future planning, management and development of the City's parks and reserves assets. | Consultation on draft strategy - June 2010. |
| Three Waters Strategy | Strategy for the future provision of water, wastewater and storm water out to 2050. Stage 1 (building flow monitoring model) completed early 2009. | Strategy to be completed October 2009. Possible consultation on Strategy in 2010. |
| Sustainability framework | A co-ordinated plan to help the city move towards its vision of a more sustainable future: <i>'A city that makes the most of its natural and built environment and which meets the needs of today's community, without jeopardising the ability of future generations to meet their needs.'</i> | City-wide consultation on sustainability issues and strategic priorities - March 2010. |
| Economic Development Strategy | To help Dunedin to become a prosperous city that values its heritage, creativity, knowledge and environment, and profits from these strengths). | Draft for consultation – mid 2010. |
