## Exchange of Pt Reserve on Irvine Road for adjoining land.

Pursuant to section 15(2) of the Reserves Act 1977, The Dunedin City Council gives notice of their intention to pass a resolution authorising the exchange of approximately 79 square metres of reserve land at 58A Irvine Road for approximately 38 square metres of private land at 60 Irvine Road (subject to survey).

A watercourse flowing through the southwestern corner of the Reserve creates a natural boundary cutting off part of the reserve. Similarly, the watercourse and a driveway in the adjoining private property cuts off part of the private land. It is these areas that are proposed to be exchanged.

The land to be acquired will provide the reserve with an additional grassed area and surrounding bush while the land to be disposed of will remove a driveway and the watercourse from the reserve. Visually, these areas look as if they are part of the reserve and private property respectively. If the exchange proceeds the privately owned land will become part of the reserve and the reserve will become privately owned land.

### Public Meeting: Hereweka/Harbour Cone Project - Preferred Management Option

In 2008 the Dunedin City Council purchased the Hereweka/Harbour Cone property at 1299 Highcliff Road on the Otago Peninsula. The Harbour Cone Project Steering Group, established to consider options for the site, has developed a vision and selected a preferred management option for the site.

The preferred option for management of the Hereweka/Harbour Cone property was accepted by the Dunedin City Council Finance and Strategy Committee in November 2009 to be included in the draft Annual Plan 2010/11 for formal consultation.

A public meeting will be held at 7.30pm on Wednesday 3 March 2010 at the Coronation Hall, Portobello. The Steering Group will outline the process undertaken in developing the preferred option for the Hereweka/Harbour Cone property.

This public meeting is a prelude to formal consultation under the draft Annual Plan 2010/11.
