# **DUNEDIN CITY CONSOLIDATED BYLAW 1991**

## **AMENDMENT NO 2 1993**

**1.1 Short Title** - This Bylaw may be cited as the Dunedin City Council Consolidated Bylaw Amendment No 2 1993.

**1.2** The Dunedin City Council Consolidated Bylaw 1991 is hereby amended as follows:

### **BYLAW PART IV - BUILDINGS, EARTHWORKS AND SIGNS**

- (a) By deleting from the heading the word “BUILDINGS”.
- (b) By repealing clauses 4.1, 4.2, 4.3 and 4.4.
- (c) By consequentially renumbering clauses 4.5, 4.6 and 4.7 as clauses 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3.

## **PART 4: EARTHWORKS AND SIGNS**

**4.1 Meaning of “Restricted Earthworks”** - Restricted Earthworks means any project or series of projects of work, other than in the course of normal agricultural activity, involving the movement of any earth or other material where the level of the existing ground surface of any ground is to be changed by more than 600 mm or where more than 10 cubic metres of material is to be moved.

**4.2 Earthworks Permits Required** - (1) - No Restricted Earthworks may be undertaken unless and until an Earthworks Permit has been issued by the Council.

(2) - All applications for Earthworks Permits shall be made on the form supplied by the Council and shall be signed by the applicant. The Council may require the applicant to provide such information as is necessary for the proper consideration of the application.

(3) - The Council may impose such conditions on any Earthworks Permit as may be necessary to ensure the health and safety of any person or the protection of any property.

**4.3 Signs Bylaw Preserved and Adopted** - Notwithstanding the provisions of 1.14, Part I of the Dunedin City Consolidated Bylaw 1977 (entitled “Advertising; Signs and Hoardings”) shall remain in full force and effect after the commencement of this Bylaw and is hereby adopted to have application throughout the City.
