I advise that queries received about the Bus Hub by the DCC, in general, are referred to the ORC for response.

After review of any correspondence held by DCC (as requested above), we provide the media release from 6 August 2024 which refers to the multi-agency Central City Safety Advisory Group established following the tragic death at the Bus Hub of Enere Taana-McLaren.
