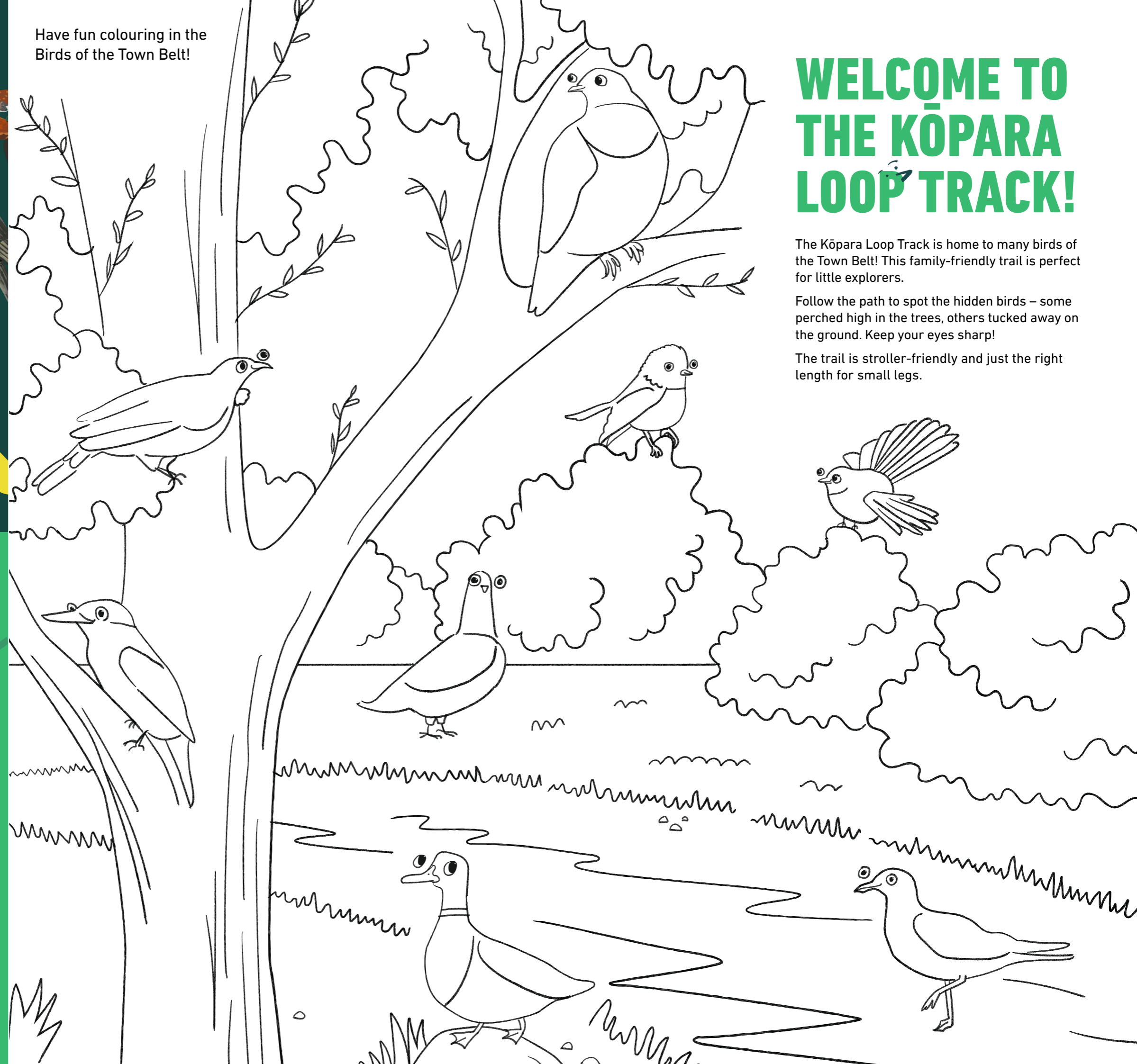
For the grown-ups
