

Blueskin Bay Area and south of site Receiving Environment




Left View from White Road, Waitati 22 January 2016, morning/sunrise. At this time of day / weather the pale coloured structures would be illuminated by the low angle sun and be potentially at their most visible. (image supplied by Sally Brown) (Viewpoint 5)

Bottom View from near Michies Crossing around mid day. Doctors Point on right. Note how the apparent visual contrast in the landscape patterning on Porteous Hill is lessened in these climatic / time of day conditions, where the structures (indicative 125m height shown by the dashed line) would be silhouetted to a similar degree (Viewpoint 3).
