My submission is:

I have owned Section 7 Blk VII SO 1275 North Harbour and Blueskin SD immediately east of the proposed building platform since 1980, and our picnic area would be only 125 m from the proposed residence, which would have a major effect on the enjoyment of the peace and quiet of this area.

Granting this application:--

- 1. Would be contrary to the purpose of the Resource Management Act and fail to protect a Visually Prominent Area (VPA) within the Flagstaff-Mt Cargill Landscape Conservation Area.
- 2. Would be contrary to both the present DCC District Plan and the Proposed 2nd Generation District Plan, since it proposes a residence on an undersized plot (less than 15 ha) in an area likely to be zoned for 40 ha minimum size of lot.
- 3. Would undermine the integrity of the District Plan and would create a bad precedent for development in this forested area so close to the Orokonui Ecosanctuary and the buffer zones being established around it.

The decision which I wish Council to make is:

To decline the application entirely for the reasons given above.

Comments on Cubitt report, Feb 2017

1.1. Description of Site.

The site is within the head of the Cedar Creek catchment which is heavily forested. The quarry and dwellings listed (p.1) to the south of the site are in the head of Weatherstone Creek or on Volco Trust land, out of sight of the Applicant's land. The head of Cedar Creek is occupied by:-

- A. The 402 ha of the DCC Mihiwaka Water Reserve, being considered as an addition to the land controlled by the Orokonui Ecosanctuary.
- B. The Initial Volco Trust set up by Lloyd and Dorothy Morris over about 104 ha.

Visually the site will be an intrusion into the steep forested headwaters of Cedar Creek.

The Applicant states that there was a farm house on the site previously. There has been no building there in my time as a neighbour, i.e. since 1980. Green's farm is marked on a 1901 topographic map (enclosed), and I was once visited by a very old Miss Green, who said she lived there as a child. She remembered being constantly miserably cold - it was an awful place to live, she said.

1.2 Proposed Activity

Paras (f), (g) and (h)

In my experience, protection as a condition of a resource consent is the weakest form of protection available for indigenous vegetation. A QEII Covenant would be much more desirable.

2.5 Disposal of effluent.

As the contour map attached to Mike Moore's report (Fig.7) shows, the contour is very steep. Rainfall is relatively high, the soil saturated for long periods in winter, and a formal investigation of on-site effluent disposal is definitely needed. Phosphates from grey water could readily drain into Cedar Creek.

3.1 Sustainability

The Applicant states that the land will be better managed if a residence is established. Native forest is very vigorous in growth in this shaded damp gully and benefits from benign neglect. Predator control in the district is vigorously managed by both OSPRI and the very active volunteer groups connected to the Ecosanctuary.

5.0 True Exception Test.

A. The adverse effects of a residence only 125 m from the haven of peace and quiet in my forest will much more than minor.

B. The arguments that the application is not contrary to policy framework of the District Plan look weak. The previous 19th century dwelling was part of a landscape occupied by small dairy farms (see enclosed 1901 map), a land use that has been almost completely replaced by lifestyle blocks and conservation land, and not provided for by the present district plan.

The statement at the end of Sec 5.0, that there that there do not seem to be any other adjacent undersized blocks without a dwelling, is wrong. There is no dwelling on my 3.9 ha block on the south east boundary of the applicant's land.

Comments on Landscape Assessment, Mike Moore 2017

Landscape Values (p.3)

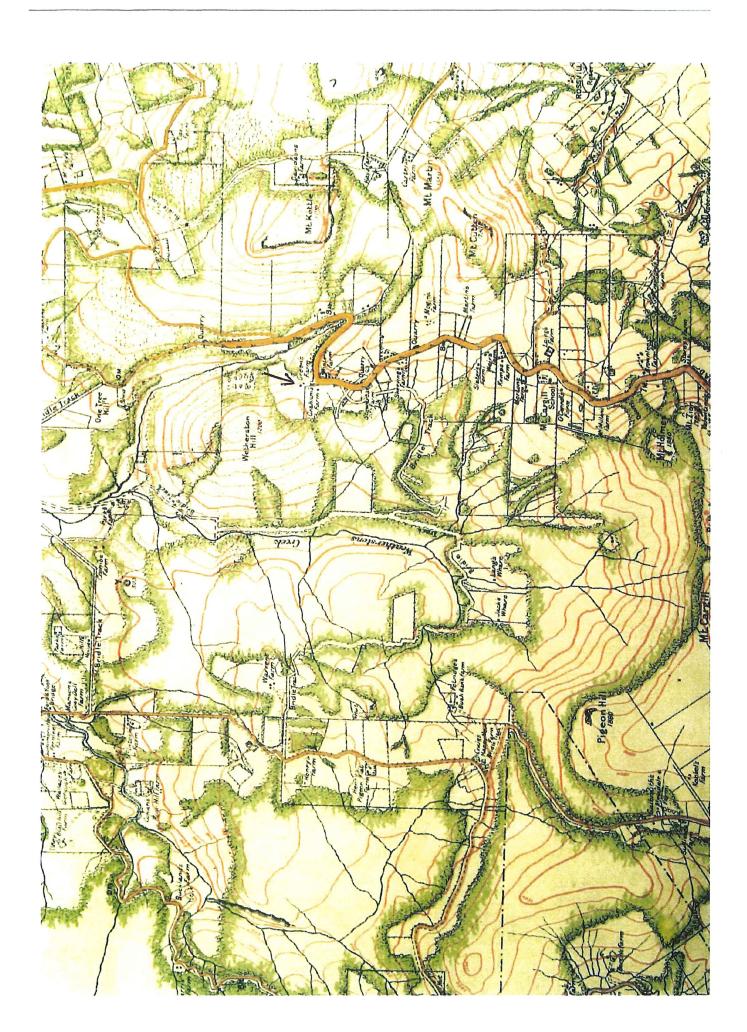
The discussion about incoherence in the pattern of vegetation in Cedar Creek can be applied to Weatherall Creek, out of sight when viewed from Mt Cargill Road, but not to Cedar Creek. The head of Cedar Creek, seen from Green Road (Moore report, Figure 6) shows a shrubland boundary at the upper right and shrubland in the foreground, marking the start of forested cover running to the left into the head of Cedar Creek. The proposed building site is well within this boundary (Moore report, Figs 5 and 6). It would be splitting hairs to describe this area of forest as incoherent because it has an uneven canopy.

The Proposed Development and Mitigation Measures. (p.5)

Having made regular use of the forest only 125 m away from the proposed house site, on the same aspect and altitude for nearly 50 years, I know how very cold the site is, even though sheltered from the full blast of southerly gales. I consider that the screen planting proposed in para (g) page 6 is unlikely to be maintained. The site faces well to the east of north, and screen planting would block both sun and view for the occupants of the proposed house site.
