Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 9 January 2016 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:

"I am interested in a particular intersections' reported crash statistics. The intersection in question is located in Dunedin, where Bone Street intersects with Highcliff Road. I understand from your website I can request this 'small amount' of information via email - thus avoiding the need for a licence to access the CAS database.

My interest is with, how many incidents there have been in the past (as far back as you records go) and the:

- 1) Time of the year it occurred*
- 2) Time of day it occurred*
- 3) Party at fault*
- 4) Visibility at the time of the incident."*

From 1 January 1980 to 31 December 2015, there were no fatal or serious injury crashes at the intersection of Bone Street and Highcliff Road, Dunedin.

This data is provided from the road traffic crash database; Crash Analysis System (CAS) and is limited to police reported crashes from 1 December 1980 to 31 December 2015, as recorded in CAS as at 12 January 2016.

It has been limited to crashes that occurred at the intersection of Bone Street and Highcliff Road. Due to the nature of non-fatal crashes it is believed that these are under-reported, with the level of under-reporting decreasing with the severity of the crash. There is a lag of approximately three months from the time of the crash to full and correct crash records within CAS due to the police reporting time frames and subsequent data processing, therefore 2015 data is provisional.
