SUMMARY

- 1. This is an addendum to the Out-of-Scope Submissions Report dated 22 April 2021 and addresses the submission by Ryman Healthcare Limited (S189) which was previously believed to be withdrawn due to a misunderstanding of the correspondence on this submission.
