Kia ora from the South Dunedin Future team! Last month we passed a major milestone when we launched into our plan-building phase for the future of South Dunedin.

This follows more than three years of open discussions and relationship building with the community in which we have met more than 2,500 people face-to-face and been to more than 100 meetings.

We now need to start building a plan to adapt South Dunedin's infrastructure and environment. This plan needs to make more room for increasing levels of rainfall, groundwater and sea-level rise, while protecting space for people and the things that matter.

New look, new ideas

We were excited to launch our new look and new flyer at the Street Festival and got a great response. We had a great day, with hundreds of good interactions with festival goers.



125 people wrote down what they want for South Dunedin's future and pinned their ideas on a map of the area. This all goes into the mix.
