Blueskin Wind Cluster 2012 Exit Survey Report

This report presents the exit survey results from community meetings held in 2012. Three separate community meetings on the Blueskin wind cluster project were held in Long Beach, Warrington and Waitati in November 2012 and the same feedback form was used at the A&P show day in Waitati in 2013 (with one response from that event).

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Executive Summary

On the 15th, 16th and 19th of November 2012, three community meetings were held in Blueskin settlements (in Long Beach hall, Warrington hall and Waitati hall respectively) to present the Blueskin Energy Project and the proposed Blueskin wind cluster. 38 forms were filled in over these three meetings, two emails on the proposal were received during the period of the meetings and one form was filled in at the Blueskin A&P show day in 13th April 2013. 88% of respondents supported the project and 12% did not support the project. These raw feedback forms constitute the body of this report.

We were particularly interested in the views of the people who came along to these meetings, asked questions, debated the issues and discussed among themselves the project. While the idea to build our own wind generation began at a community workshop in Waitati in 2006, work on making it happen was begun and has been managed by the Blueskin Resilient Communities Trust since 2009. Along the way BRCT Trustees, Staff, Volunteers and Friends have confronted the challenges of making that community dream real. The 2012 public meetings were all about reporting back on the work done, and explaining the evolution that was taking place as the project got closer to development, and we anticipated discussion and debate as we got into the pragmatic 'nitty gritty' of the proposed development

The Trust wanted reassurance that we still had the support of the community, particularly those members of the community who took an interest in BRCT work. The Trust also wanted to learn of any concerns members of the community might have, as we moved through pre-planning and had a clearer idea of what needed to be done. In short, the November meetings were a further opportunity for community engagement with the project, following the formal community engagement work that had been completed in October 2012¹.

At the close of each community meeting, community members were requested to fill out the exit poll form. Not every attendee filled out a form, and some attendees filled out one form per couple, but we are confident that we captured a truthful representation in those exit polls forms that were completed. This report provides those raw responses, with any identifiers removed. It also provides a simple analysis (below) and concludes with an assessment of the exit poll exercise and its value for BRCT.

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Analysis

This report includes all responses from all of the public meetings.

This analysis section summarises whether people supported or didn't support the project and how they feel about greater resilience for Blueskin communities. It also highlights some of the key comments collected from the research.

In summary we note that 88% supported the project and 12% did not support the project, yet nearly everyone indicated they were supportive of greater community resilience.

Key Comments

The following is a grouped selection of key comments. They are separated into four key areas: positive and negative responses for the Blueskin wind cluster proposal and on efforts to build greater resilience for Blueskin communities.

Blueskin wind cluster proposal - positive

Go for it

This cluster of comments is all about taking the project forward as fast as possible, with comments such as "go for it", "proud", "enthusiastic", "fantastic", "impressed" and the offer of money.

Wind is our commodity

This cluster of comments is about the benefits of the wind cluster project, such as "good that it is community initiative not corporate", "community return", "investors are good", "Port Otago is good because it is local", and how this could be a "model for rest of country".

Increasing resilience

This cluster of comments is about greater resilience within Blueskin such as "I want to see the turbines", and "our resilience is increasing"



Blueskin wind cluster proposal - negative

Corporate influence

This cluster of comments focuses on concerns about corporate influence, such as "need more financial control", "keep it in-house", and "worried about corporate control".

Not increasing resilience

This cluster includes comments such as "doesn't increase resilience", and "not best investment".

Efforts to build greater resilience for Blueskin communities – positive

Solar

This cluster of comments focuses on the importance of solar, especially around assisting with making solar more affordable.

Transport and Food

These comments are about how transport or food are essential elements of building resilience, such as we want more "transport solution" and "food processing resources".

Community Control

Comments include "more control in the community" and "not moving away from community ownership" as being important to resilience.

Efforts to build greater resilience for Blueskin communities - negative

Solar

Similar to the above comments but instead of them positively reinforcing how solar can aid resilience and wind generation, these comments were more about solar as opposed to wind generation. They include comments such as "solar is what the community wants", "there is more support for solar" and "\$6million is better spent on solar".

Economic hard times

These comments focus on the negative impact of "economic hard times" and how it may be "better to wait for friendlier economic climate".





As an initial investor i would accrue loyalty bonuses in terms of shares issued and regularly decreasing power charges. hopefully you could use such consumer contracts as the guarantee for a significant loan to help achieve your 6 million.

Conclusion

The quality of the exit survey feedback has been very informative for BRCT. In the 12 months since the exit survey was completed, BRCT has been able to advance the wind project substantially with robust wind data collection, solid planning, and work on the lease and the resource consent. This has all been completed under the management of the charitable trust. Now BRCT is ready to establish a company to control and manage development to achieve community objectives identified by the Trust, and informed by community feedback. Exit survey responses were very helpful in affirming the work programme, yet community participation and engagement remains essential to all we do, not simply the Blueskin wind cluster project.

The Trust of course maintains an open door policy, and provides regular community updates via regular and social media, but it is in more formalised process such as this simple survey that we are able to capture ideas and opinions to assist our work.

Many of the respondents' comments, both positive and negative have informed further Trust activity this past year, and have been enabled by increased BRCT staff numbers (from one permanent full time employee to one full time and one part time employee). Solar, climate change planning, energy advice, cosy homes: all have been added to BRCT's work programme in addition to our work on the Blueskin wind cluster, with very positive results.

BRCT works to achieve its Objectives, and has a strong Mission and ambitious Vision, but our true strength comes from the level of participation in our whole range of activities, including important feedback events such as this exit survey.
