- 1 Oceana Gold (New Zealand) Limited (**OGNZL**) wishes to be a party pursuant to section 274 of the RMA to the following proceedings:

Ravensdown Limited v Dunedin City Council (ENV-2018-CHC-237) being an appeal against decisions of the Dunedin City Council on the 2GP.

- 2 OGNZL made a submission and further submissions on the 2GP¹.
- 3 OGNZL is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the RMA.
- 4 OGNZL is interested in part of the appeal and any further relief or consequential amendments relating to this.
- 5 OGNZL is interested in the following particular issue:
- (a) Public Health and Safety – Policy 9.2.2.11
- 6 OGNZL supports the relief sought by Ravensdown Limited and agrees that the approach taken in the 2GP to the storage and use of hazardous substances should recognise that HSNO and associate regulations generally provide for appropriate management of the resource management effects of land uses. Additional regulation via resource consent requirements in the 2GP should be limited to exceptional circumstances. Compliance with HSNO requirements should be sufficient to achieve the policy outcome.
- 7 OGNZL agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
