Kia Ora Karl,

With regards to your query when I dropped by the Tansley main office this morning – I have just gotten back and been able to check with the project lead about estimated numbers of heavy vehicles using the new entrance opposite your offices.

My understanding is that the driveway opposite you will not be used for B-Trains, but more utility vehicles and the occasional box truck, with a high level estimation of 102 total movements per day (51 entering, 51 exiting). Of those 102 movements, 5 40ft container trucks are estimated to be entering and exiting the site per week (1 a day).
