The removal or pruning of a scheduled significant tree is a discretionary (unrestricted) activity under the operative District Plan. The tree rules in the Proposed Second

Generation District Plan are not yet operative.

The application indicates that tree group G028 comprises 3 distinct tree groupings and the application seeks to remove Groups 1 and 2 (26 trees in total). Group 3, comprising 32 trees, will remain but remedial pruning work will be undertaken. The application contains an assessment of effects

including arboricultural and landscape reports.
