- 1. Transpower New Zealand Limited (**Transpower**) gives notice that it wishes to be a party to the appeal by Federated Farmers of New Zealand Incorporated (**Federated Farmers**) against a decision of the Dunedin City Council on the Dunedin 2GP District Plan (**2GP**).
- 2. Transpower is a person who made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings (submissions 806 and 2453). Transpower made a submission on the provision appealed (Policy 2.3.1.7), and the appeal point concerns the same topics and issues that are prevalent throughout its submissions.
- 3. Transpower is also a person who has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the public generally for the reasons set out in its Appeal (ENV-2018-CHC-249) at paragraphs 5 to 10.
- Transpower is not a trade competitor for the purposes of 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- Transpower is interested in the part of the proceedings that may or will affect its ability to operate, maintain, develop and upgrade the National Grid, as set out in Appendix A. Transpower opposes this relief.
- 6. The general reasons for Transpower's interest in the proceedings are set out in its Notice of Appeal at paragraphs 13 to 15. In addition, and without limiting those reasons, Transpower does not support policy wording that weakens the direction in the National Policy Statement on Electricity Transmission regarding third party effects on the National Grid. Federated Farmers' relief is also inconsistent with Transpower's relief sought in its Notice of Appeal on Policy 2.3.1.7.¹
