**NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 274
OF THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991**

TAKE NOTICE that Federated Farmers of New Zealand (Inc) gives notice pursuant to s274 of the Resource Management Act 1991 that it wishes to appear as a party to the above proceedings.

This Notice is made upon the following grounds:

1. Federated Farmers of New Zealand (Inc) lodged a submission and Further submission to the District Plan to which this appeal relates and/or has an interest in these proceedings that is greater than the public generally.
2. Federated Farmers of New Zealand (Inc) is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308D of the Resource Management Act 1991.

Extent of interest

3. Federated Farmers has an interest in the following aspect of the appeal:

a. **Rule 1.4.1. Definitions: New definition of 'infrastructure'**

- We oppose the appellant's relief sought.
- Infrastructure is already defined in the RMA. Adding additional matters to the definition of infrastructure could have unanticipated consequences in the rest of the plan.

b. **Rule 1.4.1. Definitions: New definition of 'sensitive activities'**

- We oppose the appellant's relief sought.
- 'Sensitive activities' has been defined in the National Policy Statement on Electricity Transmission (NPSET). Any definition of sensitive activities in the Plan should refer back to the NPSET.
- The proposed list of sensitive activities sought by the appellant includes landfills. It is unclear what makes landfills 'sensitive' with respect to activities that may cause adverse effects.

c. **Rule 1.4.1. Definitions: 'reverse sensitivity'**

- We oppose the appellant's relief sought.
- Our submission supported the proposed definition and example.

d. **Chapter 11: Natural hazards**

4. Federated Farmers of New Zealand (Inc) agrees to attend mediation and/or dispute resolution in regard to these proceedings.
