- Silverpeaks Station Limited ("Silverpeaks Station")appeals against a decision of the Dunedin City Council on the Dunedin City Second Generation Plan ("the Decision").
- 2. Silverpeaks Station made a submission regarding the decision on the Second Generation District Plan (OS469)
- Silverpeaks Station is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308D of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4. Silverpeaks Station received notice of the decision on 7 November 2018.
- 5. The Decision was made by Dunedin City Council ("the Council").
- 6. The Decision Silverpeaks Station is appealing is:
 - (a) Natural Environment Hearings Panel Report, in particular the imposition of a Significant Natural Landscape ("SNL") overlay at Silverpeaks Station.
- 7. The reasons for my appeal are:
 - (a) The SNL overlay will impose unreasonable consent requirements for farming activity.
 - (b) The Decision erred in failing to recognise the modified landscape character of the Silverpeaks Station Land within the SNL due to historical agricultural practices;
 - (c) The values at Silverpeaks Station are not representative of the landscape values identified in Appendix A3.3.8.2 of the 2GP.

- (d) The Decision places too much weight on visibility from 'public areas' such as Jubilee Hutt as opposed to the values identified within Appendix A3.3.8.2.
- (e) The Decision erred in its application of the objectives and policies of the 2GP. In particular;
 - (i) Objective 2.4.4; and
 - (ii) Policies 2.4.4.1; 2.4.4.2; 2.4.4.3
- (f) The SNL overlay has been used a de-facto method of preventing forestry activity, as opposed to protecting the values identified within Appendix A3.3.8.2;
- (g) The Decision does not enable the relevant matters of national importance or section 7 matters to be achieved.
- (h) The Decision does not achieve sustainable management of Silverpeaks Station.
- 8. I seek the following relief:
 - (a) Remove the SNL overlay from land owned by Silverpeaks Station.
 - (b) Any other consequential relief required to give effect to the above.
 - (c) Costs of and incidental to this appeal.
- 9. I attach the following documents to this notice:
 - (a) A copy of my original submission 469;
 - (b) A copy of the relevant parts of the Natural Environment HearingsPanel Report; and
 - (c) A list of names and addresses of persons to be served with a copy of this notice.
