

RESOURCE CONSENT NOTICE

Public Notice of Application for Resource Consent Section 95A Resource Management Act 1991

The Dunedin City Council has received the following application for a resource consent:

Location of Site: 27 Cranston Street, being that land legally described as Pt Secs 3 & 4 Blk II Andersons Bay SD held in certificate of title OT280/62

Description of Application: Application to remove a Significant Tree (Lime) listed as Tree T358 in the operative and proposed District Plans.

The applicant seeks consent to remove the tree due to safety, nuisance and property damage concerns. The application contains an assessment of effects.

The removal of a scheduled significant tree is a discretionary (unrestricted) activity under Rule 15.5.1(i) of the operative District Plan.

Any person may make a submission on the application, but a person who is a trade competitor of the applicant may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the application relates that—

- (a) adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.

You may submit by delivering a written submission to City Planning, Dunedin City Council, at 50 The Octagon; submitting electronically at the website below; emailing to resconsent.submission@dcc.govt.nz; or mailing to PO Box 5045, Moray Place, Dunedin 9058. A signature is not required if you submit by electronic means. The submission must be in Form 13. Copies of this form are available from the Dunedin City Council's website via www.dunedin.govt.nz/rma.

Submissions close at midnight on 14 September 2018.
