### REVIEW OF ALCOHOL (CONTROL OF ALCOHOL IN PUBLIC PLACES) BYLAW – EARLY ENGAGEMENT

The DCC is reviewing the existing Alcohol (Control of Alcohol in Public Places) Bylaw (2004), and wants to know what you think about areas in the city where alcohol is prohibited, and any other areas where you think alcohol should be prohibited due to high levels of crime or disorder.

The bylaw currently prohibits people from bringing, possessing or consuming alcohol in a designated public area of central city Dunedin (with some exemptions). It also allows the Council to make temporary alcohol restrictions in specific areas (e.g. planned events).
