ZEALAND INCORPORATED'S WISH TO BE PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS**

1. The Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated ('Forest & Bird') wishes to be a party to the appeal by BP Oil New Zealand Limited and Others ("the Appellant") reference **ENV-2018-CHC-291** against decisions of the Dunedin City Council ("the Respondent") on the Proposed Dunedin City District Plan.
2. Forest and Bird is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C of the Resource Management Act 1991.
3. Forest and Bird submitted on the subject matter of the proceedings.
4. Forest and Bird is interested in part of the proceeding.
5. The particular issues the Society is interested in are:
 - a. Rule 10.3.3 seeking to exempt buildings, earthworks and structures associated with Port activities from the set back rule.and any consequential changes arising from or concerning the appeal.
6. The Society opposes the relief sought by the appellant, because Forest and Bird seeks provisions which maintain and enhance biodiversity values and the natural character of the coast and riparian margins. The relief sought by the appellant is broad and uncertain in terms of the potential adverse effects on the coast. The Appellant's relief seeks to amend or delete provisions Forest and Bird supported in its submissions and/or the provisions appealed overlap with Forest and Bird's own appeal.
7. Forest & Bird agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
