Bindon Holdings Limited is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.

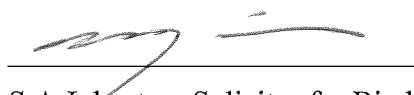
4. All of the proceedings are of interest to the party giving notice.
