- 1 The Otago Regional Council wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:
 - 1.1 The appeal dated 19 December 2018 by Fonterra Limited from the Dunedin City Council's ("DCC") decisions on its Proposed Dunedin City District Plan ("2GP").
- 2 The Otago Regional Council is:
 - 2.1 A local authority;
 - 2.2 A person who made a submission on the subject matters in the appeal, including on the relationship between the operative and proposed Regional Policy Statements and 2GP, and on Urban/Rural Design and Growth.
- 3 The Otago Regional Council is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("the Act").
- 4 The Otago Regional Council is interested in all of the proceedings.
- 5 Without derogating from paragraph 4, the Otago Regional Council is particularly interested in the appeal in respect of the relief sought on Rule 16.7.4(3).
- 6 The Otago Regional Council generally supports the relief sought in the appeal because:
 - 6.1 The relief sought results in sustainable management of land and associated resources;
 - 6.2 The relief sought gives effect to the partially operative Regional Policy Statement 2019;
 - 6.3 The relief sought assists in achieving well-designed and strategic urban growth and development;

- 6.4 The relief sought helps avoid sporadic and uncoordinated residential development;
- 6.5 The relief sought helps avoid reverse sensitivity issues;
- 6.6 The relief sought helps avoid loss of rural character, rural amenity, and rural fragmentation.
- 7 The Otago Regional Council agrees to participate in mediation or any other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
