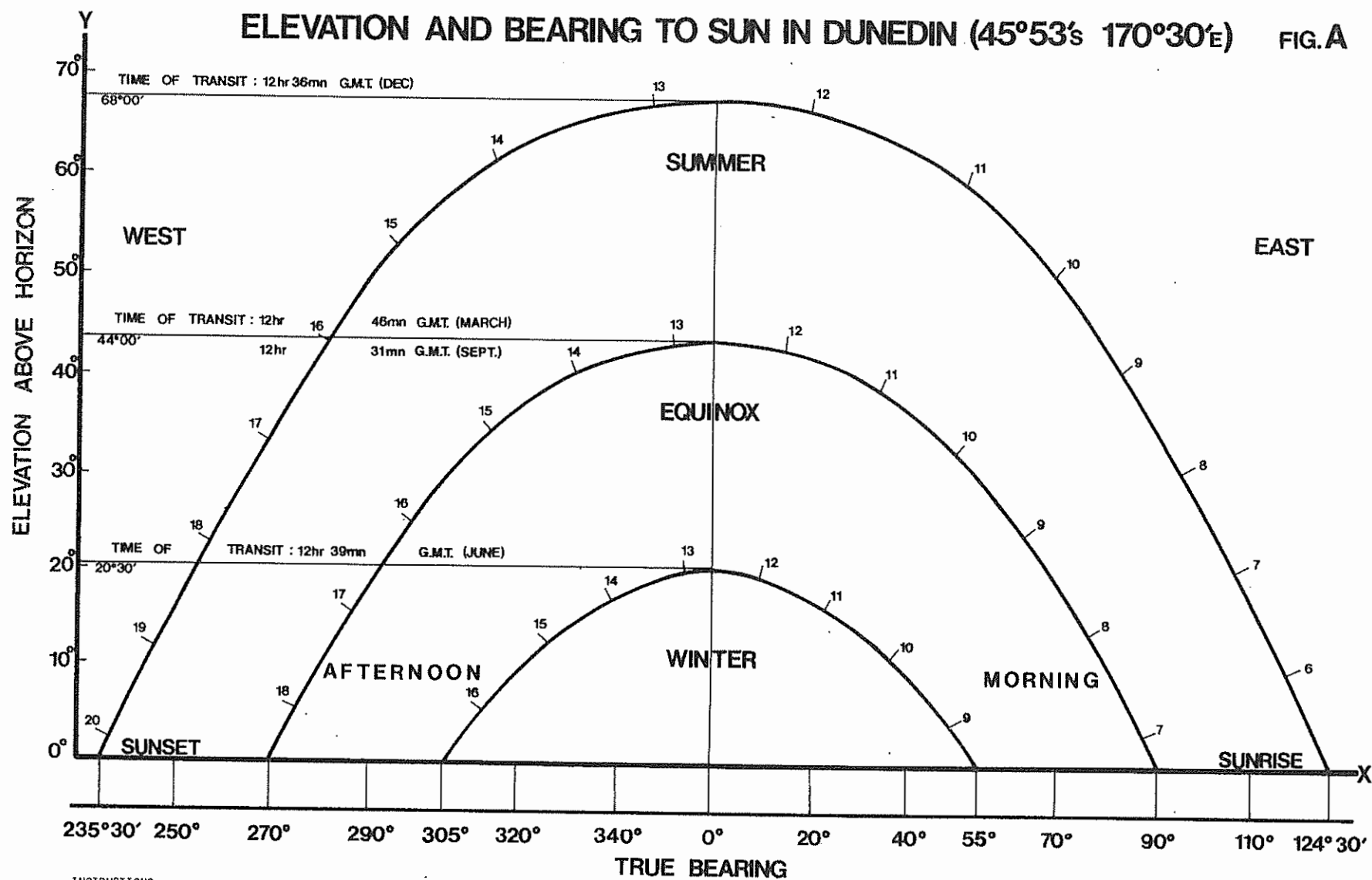


**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. For summer solstice, equinox and winter solstice, determine the local Standard Time along the appropriate graph.
2. The Y - axis then gives the angle of elevation of the sun

above the horizon and the X - axis gives the true bearing (azimuth) of the sun for the particular time.

3. For any other day of the year interpolations of the graphs are required.
