- This joint memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of Otago Regional Council (**ORC**) and Dunedin City Council (**Council** or **DCC**) in response to the directions by the Environment Court dated Thursday 15 June 2023:
 - c. that DCC and ORC are to jointly report back to the court (and serve on registered landowners and occupiers consulted) with the equivalent of a s42 report on any positions expressed by the parties and recommendations for the court to consider within three months of the consultation period ending (being by Friday 28 July 2023); and
 - d. that DCC is to advise all consulted registered landowners and occupiers of land within the North Taieri (Gordon Road) Spillway area that if they wish to become a party to the Environment Court proceedings for this appeal they must lodge a s274 party notice within 15 working days of DCC and ORC reporting back to the court.
- ORC and DCC staff have jointly prepared an equivalent s42 Report (the **Report**) in accordance with direction (c) above. This is included as **Annexure 1**.
- DCC will serve the Report to all consulted registered landowners and occupiers of land within the North Taieri (Gordon Road) Floodway area by email where an email address is provided, or otherwise by a letter including a link to the website address where the report will be available. DCC will also advise those served that if they wish to become a party to this appeal they must lodge a s274 party notice within 15 working days of the Report being filed with the Court.
