NOTICE BY THE OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL OF ITS WISH TO BE A PARTY TO PROCEEDING

- To the Registrar
 Environment Court
 Christchurch
- The OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:
 - 1.1. the appeal by J M & D R Homer dated 16 March 2023 being ENV-2023-CHC-016 from the Dunedin City Council's ("DCC") decisions on Variation 2 to its proposed Dunedin City District Plan ("2GP").
- 2. The **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** is a local authority.
- 3. The **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("the Act").
- 4. The OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL is interested in all of the proceedings.
- 5. Without derogating from Paragraph 4, the **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** is interested in the following particular issues:
 - 5.1. landscape and amenity;
 - 5.2. urban expansion;
 - 5.3. indigenous biodiversity;
 - 5.4. three waters infrastructure:
 - 5.5. impacts on Otago Regional Council assets; and
 - 5.6. contamination of freshwater.
- 6. The **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** opposes the relief sought because:
 - 6.1. the relief is not a strategic and coordinated form of urban growth and development;

- 6.2. the relief does not constitute a well-designed urban growth and development;
- 6.3. the relief will result in adverse effects on landscape and amenity values;
- 6.4. the relief is not supported by adequate three waters infrastructure;
- 6.5. it has potential for adverse effects from stormwater and wastewater discharges on the receiving environment;
- 6.6. the adverse effects on the receiving environment will have an adverse effect on the Otago Regional Council flood protection assets and their effective management;
- 6.7. the relief does not have regard to the effects of climate change;
- 6.8. the relief does not give effect to and is not needed to give effect to the National Policy Statement on Urban Development;
- 6.9. the relief is contrary to and does not give effect to the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management;
- 6.10. the relief does not give effect to the partially operative Regional Policy Statement 2019 and does not have regard to the proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement 2021;
- 6.11. the relief does not give effect to the strategic objectives and strategic policies of 2GP;
- 6.12. the relief sought will result unacceptable effects on the environment; and
- 6.13. the relief does not promote sustainable management and is contrary to Part 2 of the Act.
- 7. The **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** agrees to participate in mediation or any other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
