**Notice of Requirement for Designation – Harbourside Arterial Link;  
Frederick Street – Ravensbourne Road, Dunedin**

Thank you for forwarding a copy of the Draft Notice of Requirement for Designation of the above site.

It is understood from previous consultation and is seen as appropriate by Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou that the following condition continue to be adhered to throughout the process of the Notice of Requirement for Designation.

1. If kōiwi (human skeletal remains), waahi taoka (resource or object of importance including greenstone/pounamu), waahi tapu (place or feature of special significance) or other artefact materials are discovered work shall stop, allowing for a site inspection by the appropriate Rūnaka and their advisors and the New Zealand Historic Places Trust Regional Archaeologist. These people will determine if the discovery is likely to be extensive and whether a thorough site investigation will be required. Materials discovered should be handled and removed by takata whenua who possess knowledge of tikanga (protocol) appropriate to their removal or preservation and an appointed qualified archaeologist. (All Māori sites are protected under the Historic Places Act (1993).

Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou are also encouraged that the Dunedin City Council are committed to the Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou/Dunedin City Council Accidental Archaeological Protocol.
