DECISION ON NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT DIS-2011-1 TO ALTER DESIGNATIONS D456 AND D457

DUNEDIN CITY DISTRICT PLAN

Section 173, Resource Management Act 1991

The Dunedin City Council gives notice that the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) has decided to accept the City Council's recommendation regarding the alteration to designations D456 and 457 to provide for the Caversham Valley Safety Improvements project.

The NZTA has resolved that the designation is confirmed, subject to conditions relating to:

- The submission of a Construction Management Plan to the Dunedin City Council setting out details of traffic management during construction, and dust and noise mitigation;
- The recording, translocation and on-going management of peripatus;
- Modification and access to Council water and waste infrastructure;
- Protocols to be followed if archaeological material is discovered during construction; and
- Planting requirements

A copy of the NZTA's decision, including a full set of the conditions to be attached to the designations, can be inspected at:

Any person who made a submission on the notice of requirement for the alteration to the designations may appeal to the Environment Court against all or part of this decision. Appeals must be in the prescribed form, and must be lodged with the Court within 15 working days of the date on which notice of the decision is given.

If no appeals are made on this decision, or if, following appeals, the Environment Court resolves that the designation should be confirmed or modified, the designation will be included in the Dunedin City District Plan as soon as reasonably practicable and without further formality.
