ADOPTION OF PLAN CHANGE 10: TRANSPORTATION RULES AND DEFINITIONS

Pursuant to Clause 20(2) of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991, the Dunedin City Council gives notice that it has approved Plan Change 10: Transportation Rules and Definitions to the Dunedin City District Plan. Plan Change 10 will be operative with effect from Tuesday 18 January 2011.

Plan Change 10: Transportation Rules and Definitions makes a number of changes to the rules and assessment matters of District Plan Section 20: Transportation, and reviews associated definitions in Section 3: Definitions. The changes include: provision for bus shelters and other street furniture in the road reserve; updating of design standards and terminology; and clarification of the wording of rules. A number of consequential amendments have also been made to other District Plan sections.

The plan change amends Sections 3, 8, 9, 10, 11, 18, 20 and 25 in Volume 1 of the District Plan. The plan change also amends the Legend for Zone Maps in Volume 2 of the District Plan.
