18 Subdivision Activity

The following changes are proposed to Section 18: Subdivision Activity:

Amend Method 18.4.1 as follows:

Method 18.4.1 Code of Subdivision and Development

The Code of Subdivision <u>and Development</u> is not part of the District Plan. The <u>Code contains</u> is a guidelines as to the <u>Council's</u> preferred standards for any physical works associated with subdivision activity <u>and will be considered as an assessment matter in considering consent applications</u>.

Amend the Principal Reasons for Adopting Methods:

Principal Reasons for Adopting Methods

Rules provide a measure of certainty for both the public and the Council.

Subdivision activity can have potential adverse effects on the environment.

The amenity values of sites within a subdivision need to be enhanced and protected. Council will require as conditions of consent that works be completed to a standard which ensures this. The Code of Subdivision <u>and Development</u> provides a guideline as to those standards.

Assessment matters on resource consents will ensure identification and consideration of potential adverse effects, and assist applicants in making applications as well as assisting the Council in considering applications.

20 Transportation

The following change is proposed to Section 20: Transportation:

Amend Method 20.4.3 as follows:

Method 20.4.3 Dunedin City Council Code of Subdivision and Development

Implement the Dunedin City Council Code of Subdivision <u>and Development</u> which sets technical standards to ensure that road amenity is protected, road safety issues are addressed, and provision is made for cyclists and pedestrian links and areas.
