## RELEASE OF DECISIONS AND RECISION OF COUNCIL DECISION ON WHEN RULES HAVE LEGAL EFFECT FOR PLAN CHANGE 13: HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES

The Dunedin City Council wishes to give notice that it has made decisions on submissions and further submissions to Plan Change 13: Hazardous Substances.

Notice of the decisions is given under Clause 10(4) of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991. From the date of this notice the proposed plan change is amended in accordance with these decisions.

The Dunedin City Council also wishes to give notice that on 25 June 2012 it rescinded its decision of 11 September 2011, that all rules in the Plan Change were to have legal effect once the Plan Change became operative in accordance with Clause 20 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991. Pursuant to Section 86C of the Resource Management Act 1991, the rules of Plan Change 13: Hazardous Substances will now have legal effect from 2 July 2012.
