

COUNCILLORS: APPOINTMENTS TO OUTSIDE ORGANISATIONS

Council appointments to outside organisations should only be made where:

- a) there is a very clearly established reason for it (ie, that the Council has a close funding or functional relationship);
- b) the role, functions and expectations for the appointee have been clearly defined; and
- c) in other circumstances, informal liaison contacts should be encouraged through the Community Advisory Section.
