

ROAD STOPPING POLICY

That the Council will consider the stopping of a road, where it is not likely to be required for Council or community purposes in accordance with the processes outlined in the Local Government and Public Works Acts, and may approve notice being given of its intention to stop a road or part thereof subject to the applicant agreeing to:

1. Meet all costs the Council incurs in making the road stopping, regardless of whether or not the stopping reaches a conclusion.
2. Pay the Council the value, as assessed by the Council's Valuers, for the stopped road.
3. Amalgamate the stopped portion of the road with the title of the adjacent land that is owned by the applicant.
4. Apply the zoning of the amalgamated private title to the stopped portion of road.
5. Accept the application of the standards contained within the Dunedin City Council Code for Subdivision and Development.

Policy Review

This Policy will be reviewed in three years.
