MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT
(4 March 2020)

Introduction

[1] This Minute is issued for the purpose of case management in response to paragraphs [23] – [25] of the City Council's Group 1 Fifth Mediation Report dated 28 February 2020:

[2] Consent memoranda and supporting affidavits have been filed in relation to the appeals by William John Morrison and Grant Maxwell Motion.¹

[3] The City Council has advised that The Preservation Coalition Trust is not a party to the appeals but that its appeal point DCC reference 93, which appears to seek all 2GP-new rural residential zones being rezoned to rural zoning, affects the sites in question.

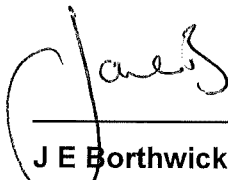
