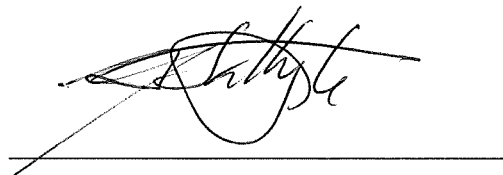
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May it please the Court:

- 1 Aukaha Limited represents Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka Ki Puketeraki and Te Rūnanga O Ōtākou (Kā Rūnaka) in proceedings relating to the Dunedin City Second Generation District Plan (2GP).
- 2 As well as being appellants, Kā Rūnaka are interested parties under section 274 to a number of different appeals. Kā Rūnaka now seek to rationalise this involvement in proceedings.
- 3 Kā Rūnaka seek to withdraw section 274 interests under the following topics:¹
 - a) Hazard facilities mapped area/bulk fuel storage infrastructure provisions
 - b) Industrial zone provisions
 - c) Hazardous substances provisions
 - d) Rural reverse sensitivity
 - e) Helicopter movements and farming
 - f) Noise from temporary generators
 - g) Deletion of electrical interference provisions
 - h) Noise and amenity in the Port Zone
 - i) Residential zoning – Mosgiel
 - j) Residential zoning – The Cove
- 4 For clarity, Appendix 1 provides a table setting out our understanding of each of these proposed topics in terms of appellants, Council appeal point numbers and other section 274 parties.
