1 Counsel refers to the Court's minute dated 9 December 2019. The Court directed that:

"PCT is to file a memorandum by 5pm, Friday 6 December 2019 clarifying whether it is seeking the extension of an ONCC overlay across land in respect of which the University of Otago has an interest;"

2 PCT instructs that:

- (a) PCT does not seek extension of an ONCC overlay across land in respect of which the University of Otago has an interest;
- (b) PCT's relief is identified in the List of Issues dated 16 April 2019. PCT is not now seeking relief for the ONF, SNL, ONCC, HNCC and NCC overlays. Accordingly Issue 8 of the List of Issues dated 16 April 2019 is amended to read:
 - 8. Whether rural parts of Otago Peninsula and Harbour Basin should be identified and protected as ONF, ONL, SNL, ONCG, HNCC, NCG under the 2GP. The indicative extent is identified on the attached plan. The coastal waters associated with the peninsula and basin should also be identified, in a non-statutory map, as ONF, ONL (recognizing the relationship between land and water, but also that the district plan has no direct jurisdiction over the CMA). This issue relates to whether the Overlay gives effect to the NZCPS. [Footnote omitted]
