## NOTICE OF PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL POINTS ON BEHALF OF AURORA ENERGY LIMITED

May it please the Court:

- This notice of withdrawal is filed on behalf of Aurora Energy Limited
   (Aurora) in respect of its appeal on the Dunedin City Council Second
   Generation Plan (2GP) (ENV-2018-CHC-277).
- 2. By way of background, the substantive parts of Aurora's appeal were addressed by way of mediation allocated Group 2 (Network Utilities) in November 2020. As part of the package of relief agreed as part of the consent order documentation it was agreed that parts of Aurora's appeal be withdrawn.
- 3. The memorandum of counsel for Dunedin City Council dated 1 December 2021 foreshadows that a notice of withdrawal is impending with respect to appeal points described with DCC reference number 240 and 243 (not to be confused with the Environment Court intituling related to appeal numbers). This notice of withdrawal follows that memorandum.
- 4. Aurora seeks to withdraw the following points of relief from its appeal:
  - (a) Relief with respect to 2GP Rule 7.5.2.1:1
    - (g) network utilities activities (excluding operation, repair, minor upgrading and maintenance of existing network utilities)
  - (b) Relief with respect to 2GP Rule 5.8.2 Assessment of restricted discretionary network utility activities and a consequential amendment to the list of potential circumstances that support the grant of consent.<sup>2</sup>
- Counsel for Aurora does not consider there will be any issues as to costs on the basis that Aurora provisionally agreed following mediation
