1. The Preservation Coalition Trust (**PCT**) lodged an appeal on the proposed Second Generation Dunedin City District Plan (ENV-2018-CHC-285).
2. On 3 March 2021 PCT filed a memorandum confirming the partial withdrawal of its 4th amended appeal seeking rezoning of land, including the rezoning of the small area of 457 Highcliff Road that is overlain by the agreed new Significant Natural Landscape (**SNL**).
3. Following discussions with the Respondent, PCT further seeks to withdraw its appeal in relation to the SNL that overlays the property at 457 Highcliff Road.
