- 1. The Preservation Coalition Trust (**PCT**) lodged an appeal on the proposed Second Generation Dunedin District Plan (ENV-2018-CHC-285).
- 2. PCT hereby withdraws its appeal.
- 3. On this basis the Environment Court need not establish a hearing regarding the 2GP A.11 Design Guidelines as sought by dcc and outlined in paragraph 3 of their counsel's memorandum to Court dated 24 February 2022. For further clarity, PCT has withdrawn its appeal regarding zoning of 3 Portobello properties, (paragraph 6), nor will it pursue the actioning of the coastal environment workplan commitment made by DCC in the August 2019 court mediation consent memorandum.
- 4. Please note for clarity that the Notice of Withdrawal does not relate to any matters or points of appeal by PCT that have been settled by consent memoranda filed by the Court. It only relates to the residual unresolved points on appeal that were scheduled for hearing in 12 May 2022.
