Notice of withdrawal of Appeal by Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu

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May it please the Court:

1. We act for Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu (**Te Rūnanga**) in relation to its appeal dated 19 December 2018 concerning the Rural Zones Decision Report and Manawhenua Decision Report as contained in the Proposed Second Generation Dunedin City District Plan (**Appeal**).
2. Te Rūnanga gives notice that it wishes to withdraw its Appeal.
3. The Appeal has been set down for mediation on 27 August 2020 in the Manawhenua mediation topic.
4. Counsel for Dunedin City Council and Te Rūnanga have been in discussions regarding the withdrawal and are agreed that there is no issue as to costs.
5. The only interested party, Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka Ki Puketeraki and Te Rūnanga O ōtākou, has also confirmed there is no issue as to costs.
6. This notice of withdrawal formally confirms that Te Rūnanga is not pursuing the appeal points raised in the Appeal and seeks the withdrawal of its appeal from the mediation on 27 August 2020.
