The following matters are submitted for the Director-General of Conservation Tumuaki Ahurei

(the Director-General):

1. The Director-General is an appellant (ENV-2018-CHC-243) in the Environment Court

as well as being a section 274 party on other appeals relating to the proposed Dunedin

City District Plan (2GP).

2. The Director-General's appeal on the 2GP has been resolved, with the Court issuing a

consent order for final matters on 7 October 2022.

3. One of the appeals on the 2GP where the Director-General is a section 274 party is the

appeal by the Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated

(Forest and Bird) (ENV-2018-CHC-287).

4. The Forest and Bird appeal has one outstanding matter in the biodiversity topic which is

scheduled for hearing in this Court from 15 March 2023.

5. As preparation for the hearing, the Director-General has reviewed her original

submissions on the 2GP. This review confirmed the Director-General did not submit or

further submit on the provisions (Policies 2.2.3.6 and 2.2.3.7) which are the subject of
