Good morning Chris,

Thank you for your email of 17 February 2015 in which you requested information about incidents involving parking wardens.

Your request has been considered under the provisions of LGOIMA and the following response is provided. I have repeated your questions and used your numbering to give context to our response.

Request 1. A breakdown showing how many reported incidents of verbal abuse, physical abuse or both, involving the Dunedin City Council's parking enforcement officers, have been recorded by the council in each of the last five years (or financial years, if easier). I'd like a separate tally for each type of incident (verbal, physical, verbal and physical) if possible.

Request 2. Copies of all reports or descriptions of each incident, with names redacted if necessary to avoid the identification of the parking officers.

Response: The information requested in 1 and 2 above is attached. We have withheld some information in the reports and descriptions of the parking incidents pursuant to section 7(2)(a) of LGOIMA in order to protect the privacy of the parties involved. We have also withheld this information pursuant to section 7(2)(f)(ii) in order to protect parking wardens from improper pressure or harassment.

Request 3. Details of how many of the incidents (if any) involved physical injuries and/or time off work, and for how long in each case.

Response: This information is withheld pursuant to sections 7 (2)(a) and 7(2)(f)(ii) of LGOIMA in order to protect the privacy of DCC officers and to protect officers from improper pressure or harassment.

Request 4. Details of how many of the incidents (if any) resulted in a referral to police and/or police prosecution.

Response: This information is included in the attached information.

We have also redacted some information in the document supplied to you relating to non-work place injuries (for example the first three lines of the last page) which falls outside the scope of your request.

Given we have withheld some information you have the right pursuant to section 27(3) of LGOIMA to have our decision to withhold information reviewed by the Office of the Ombudsman.

Verbal Abuse	[REDACTED]	01/09/09	1121	Filluel St o/s Law centre. [REDACTED] driver sounded horn, said move your bike you [REDACTED] or I will. I was issuing a notice to another vehicle at the time and said nothing. Then I explained to the driver to move on as he was double parked, he moved off giving me the finger.
Verbal Abuse and Threatening Behaviour.	[REDACTED]	10/09/09	1400 / 1500	[REDACTED] construction worker stopped in middle of the lane with other cars behind him tooting horn and blocking traffic. He did this to tell me know how much of a [REDACTED] I am. He was waving his arms in an aggressively.
Verbally Abusive	[REDACTED]	29/09/09	1610	I was in Moray Place across from Rialto. A [REDACTED] van, [REDACTED] was parked on broken yellow lines. I told him to move then he verbally abused me. Apparently he could not park on the loading zone. I told him what I could do and wear to park but didn't make any difference. He wasn't a pleasant man.
Verbal Abuse. Threatening Behaviour. Potential for injury. Police Involved.	[REDACTED]	24/09/09	1120	On Prince St, near corner of Dowling St. [REDACTED] saw a [REDACTED] van parked on broken yellow lines. Officer finished his run on the east side and come up the west side and van was still on broken yellow lines in front of pay and display area. Officer parked about 2 meters up from van so as to give [REDACTED] driver plenty of space to pull out. Officer went up to [REDACTED] driver and asked him to move off the broken yellow lines and park legally around the corner, [REDACTED] driver verbally abused officer then pulled out he swerved in to hit bike but missed so driver reversed van and when he went to go

				forward again he hit right side of bike and drove off after being told the police were called. Police came and had to go looking for driver.
Threatening Behaviour.		30/09/09	1414	[REDACTED] Gt King St o/s Centre City mall. I had just finished chalking P5 loading zone and was using my mirror to move out, when I observed a blue car swerve toward me; he had only missed me narrowly. He then stopped and waited in a park on the other side of the courtesy crossing while I allowed pedestrians to cross and pulled out in front of me stopping at the intersection slightly back from the markings watching me intently in side mirror. I left a large gap between car and me and didn't signal right hand turn till last second.

October 2009

Threatening Behaviour. Verbal Abuse.		13/10/09	1602	[REDACTED] For no apparent reason male swerved vehicle at Officer [REDACTED] while Officer was turning from George St into Dundas St. Driver was yelling unknown comments at officer.
Threatening Behaviour. Potential for injury.		14/10/09	1412	On George St I was about to chalk [REDACTED] on loading zone o/s Brumby's when I saw [REDACTED] who was the driver of [REDACTED] crossing the road with a sack barrow, so I didn't chalk it and carried on as I was about to pass him as he was almost finished crossing the road. For no apparent reason he stopped and turned the sack barrow and pushed it behind him towards the middle of the road. I had to swerve to go around it just about going on other side of the road. I heard a lady make a gasping sound like she thought I might hit the sack barrow. I only just missed it.
Threatening Behaviour. Potential for injury		14/10/10	1556	After asking woman to move off broken yellow lines at the corner of Park and George St (she was on George St) there was a male talking to female through car door. Male was interfering with Officer's direction, Female moved on. Just down the road a bit on George St corner off Dundas Street Officer was directing a driver off a bus stop when male from earlier attempted to hit officer while driving past. [REDACTED]
Aggressive Behaviour.		16/10/10	0910	Great King St o/s Liberty. [REDACTED] was parked on taxi stand while 4 pay and display parks were available. Driver returned as I was printing ticket he refused to take ticket, made comments about our being responsible for discouraging drivers because they have to pay these fines, and that there was nowhere else to park. The driver demeanour was aggressive but controlled. I said nothing in return to avoid inflaming the situation attached ticket to vehicle. Drive left and the waiting taxi moved onto taxi stand.
Threatening Behaviour		21/10/09	0903	On Brown St crn of Elm Row vehicle [REDACTED] was parked on the footpath. A male was apologetic about being there but wasn't happy when he seen he already had a ticket. He got in the vehicle and I got on my bike. I went forward past the vehicle entrance and stopped, as I was about to reverse into entrance to turn around male drove up behind me quickly. I thought he might hit me so I pulled forward, he then reversed out of street and drove off.
Threatening Behaviour.		21/10/09	0932	Cumberland St o/s museum reserve. [REDACTED] driver swerved from centre of lane towards me from other side of One Way. [REDACTED] when I observed him get out of vehicle at Knox row (apparently this driver was the chap who drove the [REDACTED] involved in George St fiasco)
Threatening Behaviour		31/10/09	1536	[REDACTED] London St o/s Bog Male driver swerved at me while chalking other vehicles, had just ticketed it for loading zone, missed me by about half a meter.

November 2009

Abusive and Threatening Behaviour	02/11/09	1228	West side of Filleul St o/s Para rubber. While ticketing a [REDACTED] an aggressive male became abusive and threatened to "do me" if I continued ticket for vehicle when completed I attached ticket then moved along Filleul St to take notes. Male then followed demanding I stop what I'm doing as we already had his details in our computer and he was getting the money to "fix it up". I tried to explain to his older male companion that the notes may help with getting the current notices cancelled. Aggressive male continued threatening and abusing me.
Threatening Behaviour	05/11/09	1133	I was chalking cars in Princes St between Jetty and Police Streets. While looking in my side mirror I saw a vehicle swerve toward me then away just before passing back end of car I was chalking. Vehicle was a [REDACTED]
Threatening Behaviour. Verbal Abuse.	09/11/09	1201	Manor place [REDACTED] While chalking a male came [REDACTED] and looked as though he was going to get into vehicle (not yet chalked). As officer rode by male went back into above building. Officer did u-turn to go and chalk vehicle when male came back out and got into another car and double parked beside unchalked vehicle. Officer did u-turn to ask male what he was doing and to move. He put vehicle into reverse – officer pulled out to go around him and indicated to the left to chalk parked vehicle. Male then went forward in an attempt to intimidate officer. He got out of vehicle and said he was trying to move vehicle into vehicle entrance in front of officer. But instead he backed vehicle into [REDACTED] As officer left he abused officer with hand gestures.
Verbal Abuse Police informed	13/11/09	1321	Bond St back of Old General Post Office. [REDACTED] Issued vehicle a ticket for no warrant. Male ran towards me, he was really abusive toward me. He wouldn't let me go I told him why he got the ticket; I put good notes in my hand-held about what happened. He said he was going to ring and complain about me as we shouldn't be giving tickets for rego and wofs. I saw a police man he said that's not on and took his rego number he was great. This man has had tickets from us before he said we chase him.
Verbal Abuse. Threatening Behaviour.	17/11/09	0750	Driver of [REDACTED] stopped in Forfar St. Male appeared angry about ticket [REDACTED] issued [REDACTED] in Glenpark ave P134. "Not paying the f'n thing. I'll get you- watch out I'll run you down on your bike." Told him he was being recorded and photographed he backed off and drove away.
Verbal Abuse. Threatening Behaviour. Potential for Injury.	17/11/09	0949	Stuart St o/s court door. Driver attempted to hit me with door. Hurlled abuse. I warned him had he hit me I would have called the police. Went off. He made threats to run me down – used many expletives- invited me out, [REDACTED]
Threatening Behaviour. Potential for Injury.	20/11/09	1004	Mailer St o/s alto café. Male driver in red car, one hand on steering wheel swerved at me crossing centre line.
Threatening Behaviour.	20/11/09	1056	Carroll St o/s of [REDACTED] Males at [REDACTED] threatened to run down officer. Male backed vehicle [REDACTED] into officer x2.

Potential for Injury. Police involved.				Police were called. Any incidents in future to be reported to police whether it is on [REDACTED] or elsewhere in Dunedin by this crowd. This includes verbal abuse and threats. Verbal warning given to offenders.
Verbal Abusive. Threatening Behaviour. Potential for Injury.	[REDACTED]	25/11/09	1205	At Castle St o/s Dunedin security centre. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Male driver started abusing me for no reason (while writing ticket for vehicle [REDACTED] calling me a f'n w'er and f..k off. When I chalked his vehicle he went right off telling me to f..k off, while I was taking vehicle details for incident book he was yelling and asking what I was doing. I told him it was a report for abusive and offensive behaviour when I was leaving he lurched his vehicle forward for my bike but he was going to hit a car parked in front so he stopped.

When I asked the male ██████████ person to move the vehicle off the footpath into a legal park, there were plenty of parks available. Male ██████████ person became very abusive and menacing, telling me to 'get real' along with a lot of foul language. Male wasn't issued a ticket as camera locked up and I waved him on he then accused me of giving him the finger. At this point I got on my bike and drove off.
Verbal Abuse.		20/02/10	1147	████████████████████ I was in Hanover St in a park writing in my book when a 75+ card holder wanted to know how to use his card. When a lady pulled up, traffic was really busy so even if I wanted to get out I would block the park. She pulled up sounded horn and said, 'move out of the park, Bitch'. She then started to abuse me in front of the old man that I was dealing with. I told her that I'm sorry but I'm dealing with a customer, She then carried on shouting abuse at me then drove away. Man said, oh my god, don't know how you can stand that. I said I take it with a grain of salt. Then about 15min later at the Hanover and Cumberland St lights she saw me and called me a "fat ██████████ get off the bike and walk. Fat ██████████'m going to ring about you, what's your name, I'm telling them you held up traffic." She went on and on till she drove away when the lights changed. I told her officer ██████████ and yes by all means ring in.
Threatening Behaviour.		22/02/10	1150	████████████████████ Vehicle was given a ticket for his receipt being face down which is a \$40 ticket. Male returned to vehicle he appeared to be unhappy about ticket. I got on bike and drove off. Male got in car and seemed to be following me, this continued for about 10min.

Threatening behaviour. Potential for Injury.		23/03/10	1439	While issuing a ticket to a vehicle in Malcolm St corner of Walsh St. Vehicle swerved toward me in a deliberate manner and dangerously closes.
Threatening Behaviour. Potential for Injury.		24/03/10	1330	o/s I was issuing vehicle a ticket when a male came out from and told me to off or he would punch me in the head he also stood in front of car so I couldn't photograph plate.
Threatening Behaviour. Potential for injury.		26/03/10	1213	in London St crn Constitution St. A car load of youths threw objects from vehicle just missing Officer.
Verbal Abuse. Threatening Behaviour.		30/03/10	1640	Moray Place o/s Bennu restaurant, was parked on Authorised Vehicles only area. I went to go talk to male driver but as I walked up to him he looked right at me and wound up his window, then turned away and wouldn't look at me. So I went to rear of vehicle took a photo and proceeded to write ticket then walked up to place ticket under wiper. Female passenger then yelled, 'What the that for? Can't you see he's on the phone'. I explained that male driver was given a chance to move, but if you move now I won't issue ticket for Licence Label being out. Male told me to can't you see I'm on the phone'. I took photo of licence label wrote ticket out and placed under wiper. Male then

Verbal Abuse. Physical Abuse. Police Called.	[REDACTED]	16/04/10	1604	On Russell St crn Arthur St. I had stopped to talk to a lady for a couple of minutes when I heard shouts of abuse coming from further up the hill. After my conversation with the lady I left and kept riding towards Arthur St and noticed 3 males standing at around [REDACTED] Russell St giving me the fingers and abuse. I said to them while riding past that I will visit this area more often if you are going to have that attitude. As I kept riding I could see out of the corner of my eye one of the males running towards me so I speed up to the corner of Russell and Arthur St to get away. When I got to the intersection I had stop as there were a number of vehicles going past. Then I felt a hard thump in the rear of my bike causing me to fall off, dropping my bike onto the road. As I stood up I turned to the male and said "that is assault" and then stepped over my bike and to the side of it while taking my cell phone out to call the police. While talking to the police a female and male witness stopped to see if I was okay and the male offender became very abusive and threatening towards the male witness. The female witness left and I suggested to the male witness he should also go as I felt frightened for his safety as the offender was very agitated and hyped up. The male witness stayed in between me and the offender when a female known to the offender came and persuade him to walk away, which he did. While standing waiting for the police to arrive another of the abusive males came up to the corner of Arthur St opposite me and asked "what the [REDACTED] I was looking at" and "had better not be [REDACTED] looking at him"
Threatening Behaviour	[REDACTED]	21/04/10	0910	[REDACTED] Princes St, corner Jetty St. I was waiting for a pedestrian to cross the intersection when a vehicle behind me revved the motor and screeched pass me missing me by inches. Unsure if it was a deliberate attempted to knock me off my bike or just impatient.

Verbal Abuse. Threatening Behaviour.	[REDACTED]	06/05/10	1454	Cumberland St o/s OUSA. [REDACTED] Male driver returned told me to [REDACTED] off twice and as I was about to print ticket and hand it to him he almost ran me over. I rang [REDACTED] about incident and later in the day male driver came up to me and apologized to me.
Physical Abuse. Threatening Behaviour	[REDACTED]	11/05/10	1606	George St o/s [REDACTED] Rego [REDACTED] I had ticketed vehicle on motorbike park and iust putting ticket under wiper when two males came out of [REDACTED] They said they were unloading boxes. One male who had a full beard [REDACTED]

				got right in my face and said why don't you get a real job as I walked away. I said I enjoy my job and the pay is good. The two males went back into the shop and I got on my bike and was finishing my notes when all of a sudden a hand came toward me with the ticket in it. He tried to grab the front of my jacket to shove the ticket down my front. I blocked him so he put it in the sleeve of my jacket at the back. I said that that was assault he seemed to think it wasn't I explained he had just invaded my space and it was classed as assault I said he had two options he could go back inside or he could carry on and I would call the police. At that point he realised that I was serious and he asked if he could have his ticket. I had to take my jacket off to get the ticket out. I then handed it to him. He sort of apologised and went back into shop. [REDACTED] organized for us to meet and he offered a formal apology.

He ignored me and I asked again he wound down window said something then wound window up.

Mr [REDACTED] came back very abusive he backed van into bike several times saying move your bike you [REDACTED] Bike didn't need to be moved as it was about 2m away and he had about 3m in front of him. He got out of van and tried to move it himself. I said I was calling the police and got my phone out, at this time he got in van and drove off.
