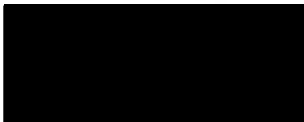

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL INFORMATION AND MEETINGS ACT 1987 (LGOIMA)
REQUEST – TRESPASS NOTICE**


I refer to your dated 7 May 2015 requesting "copies of all documentation pertaining to the trespass order served by a Dunedin police officer, on behalf of the Dunedin City Council, that prohibits me from entering the premises of Moana Pool, 60 Littlebourne Rd, Dunedin."

Your request has been considered under the provisions of LGOIMA and the Privacy Act 1993 and the following response is provided.

On 9 and 16 June 2014 you requested that the Dunedin City Council provide copies of "all documentation in respect of all complaints filed ... which encouraged the Trespass Order, issued on Monday, 2 June 2014". The Dunedin City Council responded to these requests by letter dated 9 July 2014.

There is no information which falls within the ambit of your current request that was not supplied in the response letter of 9 July 2014. I am enclosing a further copy of this information. In our letter of 9 July 2014 the names and identifying information of staff members and other persons were withheld. I repeat the advice provided in the last paragraph of the letter dated 9 July 2014, namely that you have the right pursuant to section 27 of LGOIMA to have our decision to withhold information reviewed by the Office of the Ombudsman.

REQUEST – BACKGROUND TO SERVICE OF TRESPASS NOTICE**

I refer to your letters dated 9 and 16 June 2014 requesting copies of "all documentation in respect of all complaints filed against me which encouraged the Trespass Order, issued on Monday, 2 June 2014."

Your request has been considered under the provisions of LGOIMA and the Privacy Act 1993 and the following response is provided.

I am attaching a copy of a hand-written note made following a conversation on 22 August 2012 between yourself and a Dunedin City Council (DCC) staff member. I am also attaching a copy of an email dated Friday 30 May 2014 sent to the NZ Police prior to the issuing of the Trespass Notice.

Names of staff members and other persons, and any other information which may identify them have been withheld pursuant to section 7(2)(f)(ii) of LGOIMA in order to protect those staff members from improper pressure or harassment. The information has also been withheld pursuant to section 7(2)(f)(i) of LGOIMA to enable the maintenance of the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by officers and employees of the DCC.

As some information has been withheld, you have the right to have our decision to withhold information reviewed by the Office of the Ombudsman, pursuant to section 27(1) of LGOIMA.

Hi [REDACTED]

This gentleman's name is Mathew Brown as far as I know. In August 2012 [REDACTED] he was accusing one of [REDACTED] staff of seeing his girlfriend. He believed at the time that he was being harassed by the staff here and that they were being intimidating towards him. He then went on to say that he is a complicated association with the police and they still have issues with him particularly Alistair Dickie. Also the gangs have a vendetta against him especially Black Power. This was in 2012 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] he was basically complaining about staff then proceeded to tell [REDACTED] about his life.

Roll onto 2014, he has been around but not causing any real problems, [REDACTED] remember having a conversation on poolside with him but don't remember it being anything serious. This morning [REDACTED] standing by the Duty Supervisor between 8 and 8.30am and Mathew came up and started accusing [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] saying that Mathew was a paedophile and that the accusation took place in a supermarket. [REDACTED] the Supervisor denied the accusation and said to him 'why would I call you that, I don't even know you' he said it was at Countdown which is not even the supermarket that [REDACTED] shops in. [REDACTED] stepped in after [REDACTED] tried to convince him it wasn't him and said to him that it is not okay to come here and accuse my staff of this sort of thing and that he had done this before. [REDACTED] talked to him on the phone before and [REDACTED] I am not happy that he does this to the staff here. He started talking about human rights and going to the human rights commission [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] this is the second time he has accused a member of my staff of saying or doing something they have not done. [REDACTED]
