Dear Mr Miller,

Official information requests for information about the DCC Spatial Plan and the Gordon Road/Hagart Alexander Drive intersection in Mosgiel.

I refer to your official information requests dated April 13, 2016, and June 1, 2016.

I apologise for the delay in responding to the April request and to your subsequent email. This was due to a staff miscommunication over who was to answer the request and the email. The issues raised by this delay have been resolved with the introduction of a new system for tracking official information requests. This will ensure a similar problem does not happen again.

The information you have requested is:

1. All information, including notes, correspondence and email records, and meetings between the DCC and the Mosgiel/ Taieri Community Board on the subject of the DCC Spatial plan.

In response I have attached a summary of the documents held on this issue. This includes the dates of the meetings so you can easily search the documents on our website at www.dcc.govt.nz. I have also attached a submission from the Mosgiel Taieri Community Board that is relevant.

2. All correspondence between the Dunedin City Council and NZTA in relation to the construction of the Hagart Alexander Drive / Gordon Road (SH87) intersection Mosgiel. Especially any concerns, or objections that NZTA had at the time of construction of the intersection. With Hagart Alexander Drive being part of the Dunedin City Councils preferred arterial route option for the east side of Mosgiel.

In response I have search our digital files for the key words "Gordon Road Hagart Alexander Drive Transit New Zealand". You did not include a time frame in your request so I searched back from now to 2002 when digital records began. I did not find any documents that showed any concerns by NZTA. Attached is the correspondence I found and two attachments – a design report and a traffic survey.

I trust these documents meet your needs.
