- During this period, only 1 pump was called to run at a time. Both pumps were available.
- We had no high level alarms from this station
- We had a brief power failure on the 22/07/17 from 06.46 for 26 seconds. No issues.
- Site was not checked during the wet weather event.
- The difference in Scada hours to the switchboard pump hour run meters, can be attributed to comms issues causing delays to the change of state (pump off/on) resulting in slightly inaccurate run times.
- No flow meter on either of the discharge pipes, so we do not have a measure of the volume
