Official information request for ARAMOANA WHARF information

I refer to your official information request dated 13-December-2016 for "all emails and correspondence pertaining to the above issue which relates to the DCC 12 December 2016 report including a copy of the estimate for removal."

The information you have requested is attached. A small amount of information has been redacted under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act to protect privacy, or the commercial position of contractors. There are notes on the attachments where this is the case.

You have specifically asked for a copy of the estimate for the removal of the wharf. This document has been withheld under Section 7(2)(b)(ii) of the Act because releasing it would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information. However, I can inform you that it has been reported in the media that the total cost of the demolition was \$46,080.
