Good morning Cathryn,

Your enquiry has been passed on to me in regards to landfill planning. I can advise that Green Island landfill is consented to operate until October 2023. At this stage there is no consent application to extend the operating life of the landfill. As the landfill is filling there is a programme of capping that takes place progressively. Final capping will occur from late 2023 and will continue over a two year period to completion. The transfer station and resource recovery centre operations (public area) may continue to operate.

The DCC has just engaged a new landfill operations contract with Waste Management. This company has the specific expertise to complete the works however, other specialised contractors will be engaged where required for both operational and closure works where required.

I hope this goes some way to answering your questions. If you want to discuss further I'm happy to give you a call to discuss. Just let me know what time works for you.
