I am writing in response to the series of questions that you posted on Council's facebook page on 1 February 2018. Your questions have been considered under the LGOIMA.

I advise that your questions asking for acknowledgement on various subjects are not requests for official information, and are therefore not responded to. Two questions raised by you are addressed below:

**1. What is the actual capability of the Mosgiel and South Dunedin stormwater systems?**

Mosgiel and South Dunedin. Shown below is the link to these documents for your information.

In South Dunedin 56% of the network can accept rainfall from a design rainfall event (1 in 10 years) and in Mosgiel 71% of the network can accept rainfall from a design rainfall event (1 in 10 years).
