Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act Request

I refer to your request dated 17 November 2018 for information on Bylaws.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information and Meetings Act (1987) and the following response is provided:

The Dunedin City Council does not have a Commercial Use of Footpaths Bylaw, rather it has the Commercial Use of Footpaths Policy (2005) which is to be read in conjunction with the Rooding Bylaw. Council also has a Mobile Trading and Temporary Stall Bylaw. I note however that the use of e-scooters is not specifically addressed in either the policy or bylaws.
