Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) Request

I refer to your e-mail of 9 December 2019 requesting information relating to Sport and Recreation funding. Please accept my apology for the delay in replying to you.

Please find answers to your questions below:

- 1 The options provided by Council to the community to apply for sports and recreational funding and the Council Committee/s involved in decision-making.

Within our Grants Management Policy there is opportunity for sport and recreation providers to apply for funding. A copy of the current policy may be found on the DCC website.

- 2 Through the available options the funding requests made to Council during the past 5 years for sports and recreational funding from community organisations/sports codes.
- 3 Decisions (i.e. approved/declined/deferred) relating to those funding requests and the community organisations/sports codes they relate to.
- 4 For the funding approved by Council, the amount approved, and the community organisation/sports code that received/benefited from the funding.

For questions 2 – 4 above, please see the attached list of applicants and decisions made via the Grants Subcommittee. Note is made that some requests may have been made through our Annual Plan or Long Term Plan processes. We have not provided this information due to substantial collation i.e reviewing all submissions made to identify such requests. This information is declined pursuant to section 17(e) of LGOIMA due to substantial collation. However, we have been able to locate the grants that have been approved through the Grants Subcommittee.
